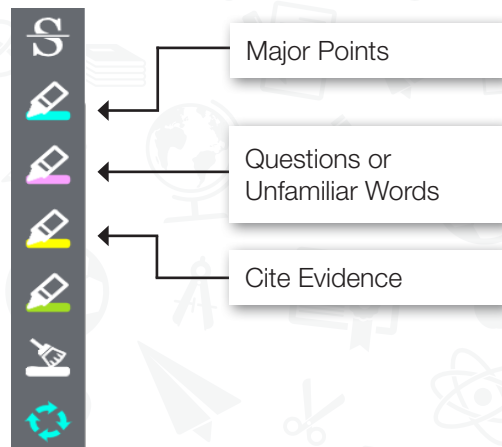
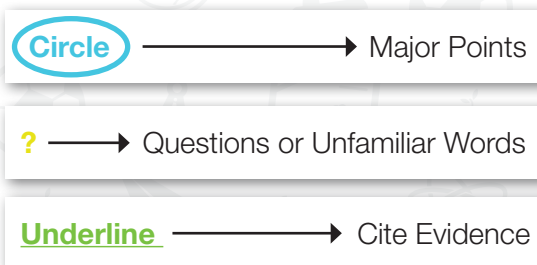


Close Reading with Complex Text Annotation Tips

The sign of true learning is when a learner can demonstrate knowledge and feel like an expert on the topic.

During a process called "close reading" a reader is able to investigate the text and draw meaning and conclusions based on information in the text.

Ways you can help to support your students with Close Reading:

- Read different types of text
- Read a piece more than once
- Mark and discuss interesting or unfamiliar words
- Underline details
- Circle main ideas
- Spend time having a discussion about the reading
- Encourage your learner to ask questions while reading
